



Hello Gorgeous! Want to try an eyelash lift and tint but are a little bit nervous? Don't worry! Here are some FAQs and helpful information that will give you some peace of mind.

What exactly does this service do?

Our eyelash lift and tint is basically an eye safe perm for your lashes. This treatment curls your lashes up, just like an eyelash curler would, but it lasts for a minimum of 4 weeks. This means your lashes will look longer. Combine this service with our jet black tint and your lashes look like you have a light layer of mascara on. Now you can wake up in the morning and have beautiful longer looking and fuller lashes without having to do anything!

Does this service damage my lashes?

No! Unlike eyelash extensions that can be applied incorrectly and too heavily to the lash, our eyelash lift and tint solutions are fortified with keratin to strengthen the lash while the treatment is working. Each service is times specifically to the individual's lash type to make sure there is no damage done and there is no chance of overprocessing.

Does it hurt?

Nope, you should not feel anything uncomfortable during this service because none of the solutions ever touch the skin and only touches the lashes

How long does this last?

The treatment will last between 4-6 weeks which is how long it takes for your lashes to go through their natural shed cycle.

Is it safe?

Yes! Both our lifting solutions and our tinting solutions are designed specifically for the more delicate hairs that are on your lashes. No sketchy amazon packages or hair dye on your eyes.

What should I do before my appointment?

Shower! It sounds so silly but you cannot get your lashes wet for 24 hours after your treatment so if you can shower before the appointment it will not only make sure your lashes are clean for the service but you also don't have to worry about neutralizing the solution from the steam in your shower. Come to the appointment with clean dry eyes with no makeup on them.

What is the maintenance?

The great thing about this service is that there is very little maintenance involved. After your treatment you CANNOT get them wet for a minimum of 24 hours. You also cannot apply any mascara to the lashes. During those 24 hours your lashes are slightly malleable because they need time to set and cure into place so try your best to sleep on your back. After the 24 hour setting period you are free to go about your life the way you normally would. You do not have to worry about jumping in the pool or wearing your favorite makeup look because you can do it all. Just make sure that you keep the lashes hydrated with the provided castor oil every night.
